Eighteen credits are required to complete the program and earn a WG Women Certificate of Completion in 2024. This requirement will increase to 20 credits starting in January 2025. At least one year of program participation will be required to achieve the requisite number of credits. New courses will be added periodically, enhancing the depth and breadth of our program offerings. Following completion of the program, WG Women participants are encouraged to attend future events to maintain and grow relationships and professional skills for years to come.
